More commonly known as 'Allo' or the Giant Himalayan Nettle its botanical name is *Girardinia diversifolia*. Nettle rugs possess a rich sheen with a subtle reflective quality similar to silk. Nettle grows wild in the remote regions of Nepal. Harsh and prickly, usually avoided at all costs, the hand-spun nettle fibre is extremely resistant and soft, perfect to create rugs. The hand-knotted Nettle rug presents a unique surface, comfortable and inviting. Many of our customers associate nettle with hemp or jute, and although they're similar, nettle has certain characteristics that set it apart. Hemp and nettle are both food, fibre, and medicinal plants used throughout the world. The fibre is a hollow fibre and is warm in the winter and cool in the summer and is luxury and strong in nature hence is very good for making carpets. Allo fiber has great features; that it is cool in summer and warm in winter, and it's quite waterproof, durable. Colour may vary which each carpet.

H E M P



Made from the finest wild growing cannabis of the Himalayas, this carpet is one of its kind and is very limited in availability and one of the premium handcrafted products. Hemp carpets are woven from hemp grass (also known as mountain grass) found in the highlands of Nepal, which is both renewable as well as pesticide free fiber. Hemp carpet is a textile product made from the stalks of industrial hemp. Hemp carpet are sustainable, highly durable, and hypoallergenic. The final product is very similar to other popular types of fabric. It can also be colored with natural or synthetic dyes. This type of carpets is very durable and have a beautiful deep tone, however the fiber is harder underfoot than sisal, jute or Sisal Wool blends. Hemp rugs absorb moisture, which can lead to mold and mildew, and therefore they are not well-suited for cleaning methods that involve water saturation, such as steam cleaning or wet shampoos.




BUBBLE DRIFT


SILKEN SERENITY



BAROQUE BLOOM


GOLDEN DUSK


TIBETAN DESIGN


